This letter is in response to your 6 Feb 19 request for the Air Force to grant VetsEDU approval to provide financial education to Airmen and their families on Air Force installations.

I hereby grant permission for VetsEDU to conduct training, provided that it complies with restrictions set forth in the Department of Defense Instruction (DoDI) 1344.07, *Personal Commercial Solicitation on Air Force Installations*, Air Force Instruction (AFI) 36-2925, and the following conditions.

The use of your approved proprietary educational training materials and employed experts in finance-related fields are subject to the following conditions:

- a. Training materials will not include endorsement or promotions of commercial services or suggest preferential treatment of any individual corporation, product, or service.
- b. Additional training materials, as well as other goods or services, will not be marketed or sold (including direct links to website were such items are marketed or sold) before, during, or after training.
- c. All training materials must include appropriate disclaimers to clarify that the trainer is not associated with, or endorsed by, the Department of Defense or the Air Force.
- d. Participants will not be invited to participate in small group or individual "one-on-one" meetings, sales pitches, personal investment reviews, or financial counseling with representatives of the training organization and personal information on class attendance will not be provided to or collected by the trainer.
- e. Educational presentations by approved trainers will only be conducted at the express request of the installation commander. VetsEDU may not contact installation

commanders, unless first contacted by an installation commander requesting you provide financial education. As a reminder, the installation commander exercises complete discretion on the duration of training and may discontinue the class at any time.

f. Approved organizations are required to provide notification of any changes or additions to previously approved training materials or trainers before implementing new or adjusted materials or trainers.

In addition, VetsEDU must provide quarterly reports including information on any event conducted on an Air Force installation, the report must include at a minimum: event date, number of participants, Air Force POC name and information, a brief event summary, and any evaluation data (if applicable).

In accordance with DODI 1344.07 and AFI 36-2925, this approval in effect until 9 January 2023, provided the actions of your organization remain compliant with the guidance and conditions set forth herein.
